- Linking between Notes, Names and Works, binding data fragments together to assist with comprehending a complete project.
 - Bidirectional links permit rapid movement between elements of a project.
- Continuation notes while writing that can be linked in a chain.
- In Notes, smashing is better than parentheses.
- Hilite 2000 is very handy for removing spaces or adding parens.
- Does not like to have ampersand in smashed title.
- Templates do not need to be in the same folder.
- When launching packages, the name of the icon is not necessarily the name of the package.
 - · Gesturing across the word 'backlight' toggles it.
 - NextLink, ContinueNote, NextPage
 - Prompts for the creation of a new note with an incremental note title.
 - Need templates for types other than plain notes.
 - Gesturing across NewtWikiOrphanedList generates a note with a list of all the notes whose titles aren't referenced by a link. No title, no entry.
